The registration fees are not prorated, regardless of enrollment or withdrawal date.

The school may at times require full payment of fees when it is considered necessary due to wait pool situations and enrollment limits. Failure to comply with the payment terms may result in loss of enrollment.

# **Online Payment**

# **Bank Transfers**

Wire transfer payments (not check deposits) may be made to the account below, and should contain the following:

#### Other Bank Charges

Bank charges for wire transfers, collecting outstation checks/drafts, bounced checks etc are the responsibility of the parents.

#### **Overdue Payments**

Fees not paid by the due date are subject to interest at an annual rate of 10%. Non-payment of fees may result in the student not being allowed to attend classes and/or withholding the student's academic records.

# **EXPLANATION OF FEES**

#### Application fee

A non-refundable fee of \$800 for each application. The application fee is valid for a twoyear period from the date of submission.

#### **Re-Enrollment Fee (Returning Students)**

A re-enrollment fee of \$2,000 is required by **March 15** to reserve a student's space in the upcoming school year. This amount is credited against tuition. From **March 16**, there will be an additional late fee of \$500. The re-enrollment fee payment is refundable until **March 31**. After this date re-enrollment fee is non-refundable and is subject to space availability. Re-enrollment of any student is subject to school approval.



# Advance Deposit (New Students)

A non-refundable payment of \$2000 is due within 10 days of accepting an admissions offer. This advance deposit secures the place for the student and will be applied to the total school fees payable.

# **One-time Registration Fee (New Students)**

A one-time, non-refundable fee of \$15,000 for newly enrolled students. \$10,000 applies to newly enrolled Pre-Kindergarten 3 students and a balance of \$5,000 will be charged in the subsequent year if the student continues in Pre-Kindergarten 4.

# Absentee Acceptance

An absentee acceptance may be secured by a qualified applicant at the discretion of the Admissions Office. This paid option reserves an available seat in the current semester for one child who is not yet attending AES.

#### **Payment of School Fees**

**For new students**, fees are due within thirty (30) days of invoicing or before the first date of joining, whichever is earlier. The school may require payment of all school fees at the time of admission, due to enrollment limits, waiting pool, or other factors. For semester 2 the fees are due by December 16.

**For returning students**, the re-enrollment fee is due by March 15, 2022 and all other school fees must be paid by May 31. Failure to pay all school fees by the May 31 deadline will result in a late-payment fee and may also result in the student losing the space for the upcoming school year.

\*Bus/Lunch fees will be refunded in full for the quarter(s) not attended by the student.

In the case of a force majeure event, the Head of the School will act in the interest of the students.
